### Who are the Friends?

The Friends of the West Hurley Public Library are people who support the services and mission of the library. They volunteer their time for such activities as fundraising, community relations and library service.

### What do Friends do?

Friends plan and sponsor fundraisers to provide support for library services, programs and capital projects. They also volunteer their time in the library; promote awareness of library services, legislation and programs to the community; and they support the Board of Trustees and the Director.

### Why do we need Friends?

In 1981, a group of volunteers privately raised the funds necessary to establish our current library building. A Friends Group was later established to raise money, support library programs and introduce creative projects to the Board. Our goal now is to create a new Friends Group that we hope will live up to the tradition of the original group. Our aim is to create a stronger,

more vital library presence in our community.

### Where can Friends help most?

Friends can volunteer to help with the October Crafts Fair (advertising for and contacting vendors; contacting media; posting signs around town); solicit and pick up donations from local businesses; organize donations for white elephant and bake sales; work the day of the Fair (at the tables; setting up and cleaning up).

Friends can also help mail the library newsletter (labeling, sealing and sorting three times/year); provide outreach to homebound patrons; be summer reading program volunteers; and process and repair books. Can you think of other ways to help the library?
