**Q. When will you be in the new library?**

**A.** Hopefully in late spring of 2004.

**Q. When do seniors meet and where?**

**A.** Every Wednesday at the Beekman Recreation Community Center on Recreation Road. Exercise is offered from 9–10 A.M. and from 10 A.M.–2 P.M. seniors can enjoy a variety of activities and events. Contact Sue Gartner at (845) 221-1783 for more information.

**Q. Where can I find a notary public?**

**A.** The Town Clerk, Virginia Ward, is a notary. Her office is at 4 Main Street. You can call the office at (845) 724-5300, or email your question to [beekmanc@aol.com](mailto:beekmanc@aol.com). The manager of Beekman Pharmacy, Marge Ruiz, is also a notary public. The pharmacy is located off of Route 55 in the Town Plaza, and can be phoned at (845) 724-3200.

**Q. How do I find the Beekman Rec?**

**A.** Turn right at Beekman Road and left onto Recreation Road. The entrance is on the right past the entrance to Dalton farms.

**Q. Where is Town Hall?**

**A.** Beekman Town Hall is at 4 Main Street in the hamlet of Poughquag. Go down Route 55 past Gardner Hollow Road (on left) and turn right at the sign for the hamlet. Continue down Main Street. Town Hall is the beautiful stone building just past the Methodist Church.

**Q. Will the library staff stay the same nice people that they are now?**

**A.** It is, and always has been the policy of the staff

of the Beekman Library to put the patron first. We make an effort to greet every person individually. There will be no change to the warm atmosphere that we have always maintained.

**Q. Will you have book sales?**
