***Frequently Asked Questions About the
Town of Southeast and the Brewster Public
Library***

Q. What programs and services does the library offer? (For example: *What are your hours? When is story time? Do you rent movies? etc.*)

A. You can learn this information quickly by visiting us online at www.brewsterlibrary.org. We also have a nice bookmark that lists our library hours and other general information, as well as a flyer that details our programs for children and adults.

Q. Are adult education courses available in the community?

A. The Brewster Adult Education offers a wide variety of courses for all ages and interests. Classes are held six days a week in all school buildings. Please call (845) 279-5051, ext. 54 or visit their website at www.brewsterschools.org/adulted/. We also have flyers when they are available, so please ask.

Q. Where is the post office?

A. The post office is on Doansburgh Road off of Route 22. There is also a Mail Station across from the Metro North Railroad in the Village.

Q. Where is Town Hall?

A. 1 Main Street in the village of Brewster, just across from the train station. The phone number for the Town Clerk is (845) 279-2196.

Q. Do you offer ESL classes?


A. No, classes are offered through Putnam County BOCES. You can call (845) 248-2416 for more information. We also have flyers when they are available, so please ask.

Q. What recreation does this town offer?

A.
