

# {Frequently Asked Questions} **Get the FAQs at your Library**

## **Q. Where's Town Hall?**

- A.** Down the block from the library on the right at 12 Church Street. They can be phoned directly at (845) 691- 2197 or visit them online at [www.townofloyd.com](http://www.townofloyd.com).

## **Q. Where are the schools?**

- A.** To get to the Middle School travel up Main Street. You will pass St Augustine's Church on the right. The School is just past the Church on the right. To get to the Elementary School, take the right-hand turn onto North Road, or directly after the Middle School. Take your second right onto Wood Street then first left into the Elementary School driveway. To get to the High School follow Main Street out towards New Paltz. Take the first left onto Pancake Hollow Road. The school will be on the right across from Wilklow Farms.

## **Q. Where can I get a map of the town?**

- A.** We have a map here for library use. Copies can be made if needed.

## **Q. Is there a place to donate food, clothing, books, etc.?**

- A.** The Community Action, which is located up the block from the Library on the left on Church Street, directly across from the Town Hall. They are always looking for food, clothing, toys, etc. Books can also be donated to local nursing homes. There is one down the block from the Library. Take your first right after Presbyterian Church and you will see the home on the right.

## **Q. Where is a good place to eat?**

- A.** There are two pizza parlors right in town plus a Chinese restaurant on the corner. Elia's deli makes a good lunch. The Highland Cafe right across the street has a wonderful breakfast and lunch menu. Here is a list of names, phone numbers, and locations of various local restaurants:

### **Q. What are your hours?**

**A.** M•W•F 10–5 | T•Th 1–8 | Sat 10–4. We offer a magnet listing our hours that you can place on your fridge. Please request one if you'll find it helpful.

### **Q. How old do you have to be to get a library card?**

**A.** There is no age requirement. You just need to be able to write your first and last name.

### **Q. Does the library have story hours?**

**A.** The Highland Public Library offers two story hours on Wednesdays for 3–5 year olds at 11 A.M. and 2 P.M. On Friday mornings we offer storytime for 2-year olds and their parent or caregiver at 10:15 A.M. and 11:15 A.M. Registration is required. You can call the Library at (845) 691-2275 to register. For kids' crafts and cooking programs you must sign-in at the Library.
