

Dear Wayne County Voter:

We are writing to ask for your support of Issue 6, a 0.25 mil bond issue for the construction of a new main library for Wayne County at the cost of \$8 per year for a \$100,000 house.

The proposed building is

The Right Size      45,000 square feet, fully accessible to people with disabilities and over 120 parking places

At the Right time    the future of our County is in our hands and our responsibility

At the Right Price    \$10 million

The existing building will be used for administrative and technical services functions of the library. This will save millions in construction costs and provide a positive use for a building that would otherwise stand abandoned because of the high costs of renovation or demolition associated with asbestos abatement.

**\$2.6 million has been pledged** from the private sector to keep the millage low. These pledges are contingent on the bond issue passing.

Passage of the bond issue will make the library eligible for a **\$1 million matching grant** from the National Endowment for the Humanities.

Help us look toward the future—and take full advantage of the money already pledged.
