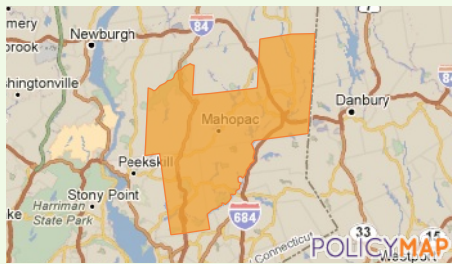

Incomes:

The median household income for the study area ranged from \$39,366 to \$149,464, compared to the state of New York with a median of \$59,269, as estimated for 2011-2015 by the Census' American Community Survey.

The number of households divided by income categories is shown in the Annual Income Category table. In 2015, 23.22% of households in the study area had an annual income of less than \$50,000, compared to 43.4% of people in the state of New York.

Immigration:

Data from the U.S. Census Bureau for 2011-2015 indicate that 16,757 people or 12.49% of the population living in this area were "foreign born". Census defines foreign born as anyone who is not a U.S. citizen at birth. This area is located in New York, which, according to the Department of Homeland Security, was home to 141,406 people who were granted Legal Permanent Residence status in 2014. Those LPRs, or "green cards", represent 13.91% of green cards issued in the nation that year.

Tenure:
