There were **486** programs for adults & kids in 2013!

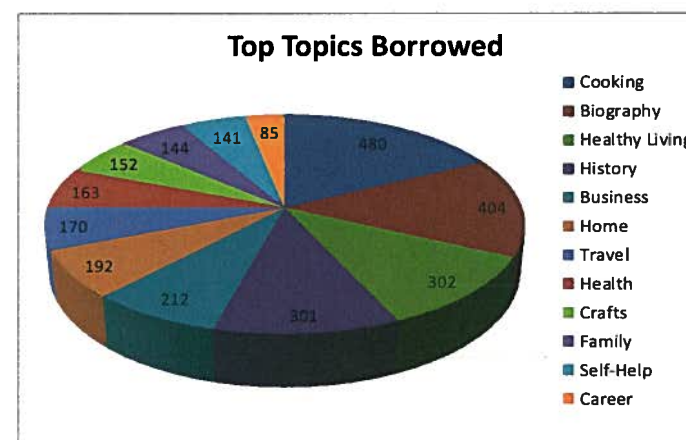
**3,233** adults attended library programs in 2013.

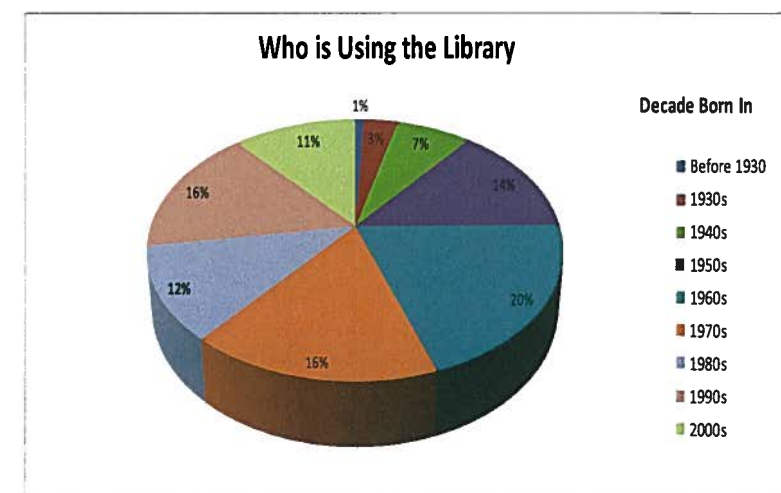
**3,166** people receive a monthly email newsletter with program information and news!
