

# Plan of Service Focus Group Session

## Ulster County Trustees | February 23, 2011

### Challenges & Issues:

- **Facilities**

- Dealing with lack of space, renovation and expansion projects was the #1 self-identified challenge.
- Libraries are simply out of space; “for books and people.”
- More patrons are seeking space to use; “We don't have room for people to just sit down and read.”
- Lack of handicapped accessibility
- Lack of space for programming
- Lack of office space for staff is hindering operations; clutter is becoming a major problem
- Lack of parking is a big issue for many.
- Space for computers competes with space for people and books.
- Looking to maximize what they have – making most efficient use of space.
- A fair number are seeking to build new buildings or move to a new location
- Seeking ways to make their buildings more energy efficient and “green.”
- Concerned about having the finances; “patrons seem apathetic about space needs”
- More libraries would like to explore Dewey-free system

- **Funding**

- Concern that the funds “just won't be there” in the future for library funding
- Trustees are concerned that they are not keeping up with providing adequate salaries
- Worried about upcoming budget votes: “Taxpayers seem unwilling and suspicious of giving us more money.”
- Low voter turn out
- Budgets are not sustainable. Reserves are shrinking.
- “Fear” of asking for more
- Feeling that small libraries are competing with larger libraries
- Working together, through the System, makes operations affordable

- **Community Awareness**

- Would like to increase overall community awareness of the value of the library and the specifics of what we have to offer
- Would like to increase affiliation and partnerships in the library's “neighborhood”
- Libraries are becoming more about a meeting place – connecting with other people. “We're the hub, the new town square.”



- Feeling that they have less interaction with the community due to lack of programming space.
- "There seems to be a lot of misperceptions about who uses the library out there."
- Access to materials through System services impresses users
- **Technology**
  - Computers have become a "centerpiece."
  - Big concerns about "keeping up with technology"
    - Funding
    - Staff know-how
- **Board Development**

  - Very keen to make sure they are offering the services that matter most to the community.
  - Many are hoping to develop comprehensive facility plans.
  - "As we become more of a gathering place, how does this shift our mission?"
  - Concerned about collection development and format type expansion
  - Libraries want to be proactive
